

Invitation to a RES2020 Workshop 10th November from 16.00-18.00,

In the framework of the RES2020 project¹, a modelling approach is used for the EU27 countries in order to examine the targets for renewables for 2020.

Four scenarios have been defined in order to examine the effect of different policy options on the achievement of the targets set for 2020.

In this context the objectives of the proposed workshop is to:

- To get feedback from the national experts on the model input (potential data, scenarios, policy options etc).
- Ensure the direct involvement of national experts in the analysis of the scenario results and get their feedback on the results for each of the EU27.

The members of the RES2020 consortium will present

- The basic principle of the model and the data input.
- The scenarios definitions.
- The set of results regarding the RES penetration in the energy system of each of the EU27 countries.

The **aim** of the workshop is to get feedback on the data-assumptions and also a critical review of the results that have been obtained. Since the issue is very sensitive politically, input from the national experts is important.

Based on the above, the **target group** that the workshop aims at are national experts on energy statistics, energy modelling, and renewable energy technologies and RES potential for all the EU27 countries.

The workshop will be held one day before the Joint Research Centre workshop on "**Data Gathering on Renewable Energies for the New Member States and Candidate Countries**" (<http://ec.europa.eu/dgs/jrc/>), at the same location
